

REGULATIONS

1. As part of the “Luso Half Marathon” program, a race of about 8,200 meters called “EDP Mini Marathon” will be held simultaneously on October 8th. This competition will be broadcast live by RTP and with the collaboration of the local government of Lisbon, as well as other official entities, including the PNDpT – National Sports Program for All.

2. The EDP Mini Marathon will start at 10:30 am and the route will be identical to that of the “Luso Half Marathon”, up to Km 7.

3. Registration must be made on the event's website, at www.marathonportugal.com

a) The registration periods and corresponding registration fees are available on the race website;

b) A maximum limit of 8,000 athletes will be stipulated, with entries limited to participants over 16 years of age;

c) Requests to change registration will not be accepted. Entries are personal and non-transferable;

d) Under no circumstances will the organization refund the registration fee;

e) The organization may, at any time, suspend or extend the deadlines, or add or limit the number of registrations for the event, according to availability/technical/structural needs, without prior notice.

4. There will be no individual or collective results and the prizes will only be symbolic and strictly the same for all participants;

5. There will be an adequate official supply service at Km3 and next to the Goal. There are areas to control the passage of runners, and any athlete who does not complete the entire course will be disqualified;

6. The “running kit” will be delivered at the time of lifting the bib number and contains:

a) A technical fiber T-shirt with 5 sizes available, the stock of sizes being distributed according to availability. If the requested t-shirt size is out of stock, an alternative size will be suggested;

b) A bib number with an identification chip;

c) A bag of personal equipment;

d) Other gifts and information from race sponsors.

7. Duly registered athletes will be able to collect their bib number and respective “race kit” at the Sala Tejo – Altice Arena, on October 5th, 6th and 7th, from 10:00 am to 8:00 pm, with no documentation being distributed on the day of the race.

- a) To collect the “race kit”, it will be necessary to present the respective proof sent by the organization to the athlete's email and the respective identification document;
- b) The bib number is non-transferable and when used by another individual, it will disqualify him;
- c) The bib number will only be delivered to the athlete himself.

8. Athletes will benefit from personal accident insurance, as provided for in paragraph 15 of article 18 of Decree-Law no. treatment costs up to €4000.00, although the organization has a careful medical assistance service throughout the race and in the finish area, where a hospital tent will be installed. Participants must meet the necessary health conditions for the physical effort inherent to the Mini Marathon, assuming, after registration, that they feel psychologically fit for this effort.

- a) Hospital da Luz and Femédica are the healthcare partners responsible for organizing the Official Medical Services.

9. The organization has structured a medical assistance service, under the guidance of a specialized team of professionals, although it is not responsible for any accident that may occur during this event.

10. Disqualification of an athlete will occur when:

- a) Damage the bib number;
- b) Fold the bib number in order to reduce its size;
- c) Jump barriers either in the Race Start Area or in the Finish Line Area;
- d) Does not respect the signage of the event;
- e) Does not complete the entire route;
- f) Falsify any element relating to your registration;
- g) Manifests physical discomfort or apparent weakness before the Race;
- h) Manifest unsportsmanlike behavior.

Note: Athletes without a bib number will not be allowed to remain on the course.

10. The athlete, when registering, authorizes the transfer, free of charge and unconditionally, to the organization of the event and to its associates and sponsors, the rights to use his image as it was captured in the footage or photos that will take place during the event, authorizing its reproduction in communicational support pieces.

11. The organization reserves the right to use the database, with the elements filled in by the participants, in their eventual promotion actions, among others.

12. When registering, all participants automatically declare that they agree with the following disclaimer:

- a) I have read and I agree with the Regulations of the Maratona Clube de Portugal, available on the event's website;
- b) I am aware of my state of health, and that I am physically and psychologically able to participate in the Mini Marathon;
- c) I assume that I will abstain from participating in the race, if my health conditions change after registration;
- d) I am aware of the content of the insurance policy in force and have read its specifications, contained in the Regulation of the Event;
- e) By participating in the competition, I authorize, free of charge and unconditionally, that the organization and the competition partners use my image. By this instrument, I grant all rights to use my image, as captured in photographs and footage that will take place during the race, waiving the receipt of any amount that may be earned with its dissemination in support communication pieces. ;
- f) I participate in the event of my own free will, exempting the organization, partners, directors, employees and other companies linked to the organization of the event, from any liability resulting from my participation in the event, before, during and after it (eg. loss of personal objects through theft, damage, or other circumstances).

11. If the athlete does not want his data to be used, he is given the option of not authorizing the transfer of the same, and he must alert the organization to that effect.

12. The race course may be altered or canceled due to factors external to the organization (extreme weather conditions, demonstrations, strikes, government restrictions, works, security, etc.).

13. It is expressly forbidden the participation of people with pets, baby carriages, skates, as well as any other auxiliary means of locomotion.

14. The organization has several platforms to support participants doubts, which should be consulted if necessary.

15. Cases not covered by this regulation will be resolved by the Technical Director of the event and in accordance with the official regulations in force and WA/AIMS opinions.
