

FAQ'S

1. What is EDP Lisboa, a mulher e a vida?

A: EDP Lisboa, a mulher e a vida is a non-competitive athletics event, which takes place on the 14th of May, and is organized by Maratona Clube de Portugal with the support of the Lisbon City Council as well as other official entities.

2. What is the route?

A: The start will be in Santos (at the back of the Restaurant “Kais”), heading towards Belém along Rua Cintura do Porto de Lisboa, passing under the Viaduto da Av. Infante Santo. Continuing along Av. Brasília, the participants go along the road to the “Vela Latina”, and from here they follow, in the normal direction of traffic, to the Torre de Belém, where the Finish Line is installed.

3. What is the race distance?

A: the race will take place over a distance of 5 km, totally urban, on asphalt.

4. What time does the race start?

A: The Race starts at 10:30 am

5. When do registrations open and close?

A: registrations are open and will close on May 13th, at 7:59 pm, unless they sell out, before this date.

6. Where can I register?

A: Registrations are exclusively on the official race website at www.maratonaclubedeportugal.com

7. How can I access the course?

A: you can access the course on the race's official website at www.maratonaclubedeportugal.com

8. After registering, how do I collect my participation kit?

A: After you register and up to one week before the race, you will receive an email with the confirmation to collect your participation kit. With that same proof, you will have to go to the Seaside Sport Expo, at Centro cultural de Belém (CCB), on 12th or 13th of May (between 10:00am and 8:00pm) to

withdraw your participation kit, which includes your bib number, the official race t-shirt and other offers from our sponsors.

9. I lost my registration receipt... how can I collect my participation kit?

A: You can retrieve it on the official website in the “Consult your registration” area or at Seaside Sport Expo, going to the Solutions desk so that we can find your registration on the database.

10. What if I can't participate after registering?

A: You can transfer your registration to another participant nominated by you and at no additional cost by sending an email to info@maratonaportugal.com

11. What should I do if I lose my bib number?

A: You must contact info@maratonaportugal.com

12. Can I withdraw the participation kit of a friend of mine?

A: Yes, you can as long as you present the original proof and a copy of his/her identification document.

13. Can I use someone else's bib number?

A: No, if any participant uses a bib number from another athlete, without previously informing the organization and without its authorization, he will be disqualified. You must inform the organization within 15 working days for the change to be made correctly in our system.

14. I would like my race to be timed. How should I proceed?

A: You must contact info@maratonaportugal.com to have a chip assigned to you.

15. On the day of the race, can I use public transportation for free?

A: Yes, upon presentation of your bib number, the athlete has at his disposal free transportation, from the organization's partners.

16. Can I pick up my bib number on the day of the race?

A: No. Bib numbers won't be issued on the day of the race.

17. Is there a time limit to complete the race?

A: Yes, the time limit is 1 hour and 30 minutes after the starting gun.

18. What is served in the supply areas?

A: It will be served water

19. Is there a medical support throughout the race and at the finish line?

A: Femédica and Hospital da Luz will be in close collaboration to provide the necessary medical support during the race and in the finish line.

20. Is there a place to store objects?

A: We are sorry, but the organization does not have a place to store objects.

21. Are there showers available?

A: Sorry, there will be no showers

22. Do I get a medal if I participate in the race?

A: Yes, if you participate and finish the race, you will receive a finisher's medal.

23. Where and when will the results be announced?

A: The unofficial results will be available on the official website from 7:00 pm. Official results will be available two weeks after the end of the event.

24. I injured myself during the race and I intend to claim insurance. How should I proceed?

A: You must send an email to geral@maratonaportugal.com as soon as possible, so that you can fill the form for this purpose and thus help you activate your personal accident insurance. Maratona Clube de Portugal will send the competed document, and the insurance company will contact you afterwards
