



REGULATIONS

1. As part of the program of the “EDP Lisbon Half Marathon”, the EDP Mini Campeões social event, will take place on the afternoon of Saturday, March 11 at 4:00pm. It is a race for young people with distances approximately of 600m, 900m, 1500m and 2500m.
2. The course has the following itinerary: concentration next to the Estação Fluvial de Belém. In front of the Electricity Museum, heading towards the grassy area surrounding the Terreiro das Missas.
3. Registration for this event is made online at www.maratonaclubedeportugal.com or at Seaside SportExpo, on the days before the race, between 10:00am and 8:00pm
4. Duly registered athletes may pick up their bib number and respective “Participation Kit” at the Centro Cultural de Belém on March 9 and 10 2023, with no documentation/materials being distributed on the day of the competition.
 - 4.1. To collect the bib number, it will be necessary to present the printed document of the online registration and the identification document of the athlete.
5. The bib number is non-transferable and when used by another individual, it will disqualify that individual.
6. In terms of final classifications, four groups are considered based on the following ages: 6/9 years old, 10/11 years old, 12/13 years old and 14/17 years old. The “valid” ages are exactly those of the age of the participant on the day of the race.
7. The organization has structured a medical assistance service, under the guidance of a specialized team of professionals, although it is not responsible for any accident that may occur during this event.
8. Athletes duly registered will be covered by personal accident insurance, as provided for in n.º 1 of article 9º of DL n.º 146/93 of April 26 with an 28 000,00 EUR for death or permanent injury and treatment costs up to



4 514,00 EUR, although the organization has a medical assistance service throughout the race and in the finish line area where a Hospital tent will be installed. Participants must meet the necessary health conditions for the effort inherent in the race, assuming after registration that they feel physically and psychologically fit for the effort. In the event of an accident, they should contact Maratona Clube de Portugal (MCP) via email geral@maratonaportugal.com in order to fill out the [Accident Form](#) to be sent to the insurance company by MCP.

9. The athlete's guardian, when registering, authorizes the transfer, free of charge and unconditionally, to the organization of the event and to its associates and sponsors, the rights to use their image as captured in film or photos that will take place during the event, authorizing their reproduction in communicational support pieces,
10. The organization reserves the right to use the database with the elements filled out by the guardians of the participants in their eventual promotional pieces or other actions.
11. When registering, the guardians of all participants automatically declare that they agree with the following disclaimer:
 - 11.1. I have read and I agree with the Regulations of Maratona Clube de Portugal, available on the event's website;
 - 11.2. I am aware of the health status of my student and I am responsible for being physically and psychologically able to participate in the competition;
 - 11.3. I assume that I will abstain my pupil from participating in the race is his/her health conditions change after registration;
 - 11.4. I am aware of the content of the insurance policy and have read it's specifications.
 - 11.5. By participating in the race, I authorize, free of charge and unconditionally, that the organization and the partners of the event use the image of my pupil. By this instrument, I grant all rights to use the image of my pupil, captured in photographs and footage that will take place during the race, waving the receipt of any amount that may be earned with its dissemination in support communication pieces;
 - 11.6. I declare that my pupil, participates in the race of his/her own free will, exempting the organization, partners, director, employees and other



companies linked to the organization of the event from any liability resulting from their participation in the race, before, during and after it (eg loss of personal belongings due to theft or other circumstances).

12. All participants will receive a t-shirt, a medal and other souvenirs alluding to the event.
13. The race can be canceled due to major factors beyond the organization's control (extreme weather conditions, demonstration, government restrictions etc...). In case of postponement, the organization guarantees the automatic transfer of registrations of all athletes to the new proposed date. The organization may, in exceptional case, have to change the course, namely the place of the start and/or finish areas, as well as the race times.
14. Cases not covered by this regulation will be resolved by the Technical Director of the event and in accordance with the official regulations.
